



Revenue totaled \$916,192, and expenses were \$935,948 during FY24-25, creating a deficit of \$19,756. This was largely related to one-time move and facilities expenses.

- Have an income at or below 200% of the federal poverty level (that's less than \$31,300 for one person or \$39,440 for two people.)
- Live in Freeport, Brunswick, Harpswell and the Islands, Durham, or Sagadahoc County
