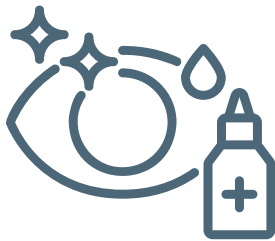

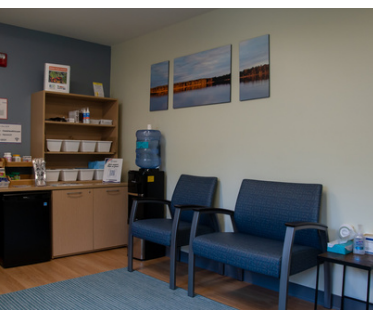

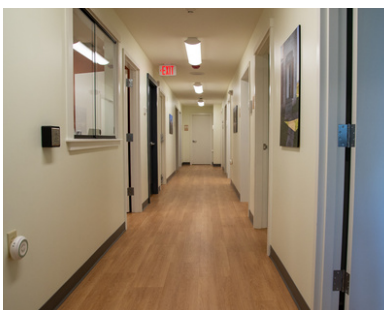


OUR NEW OASIS

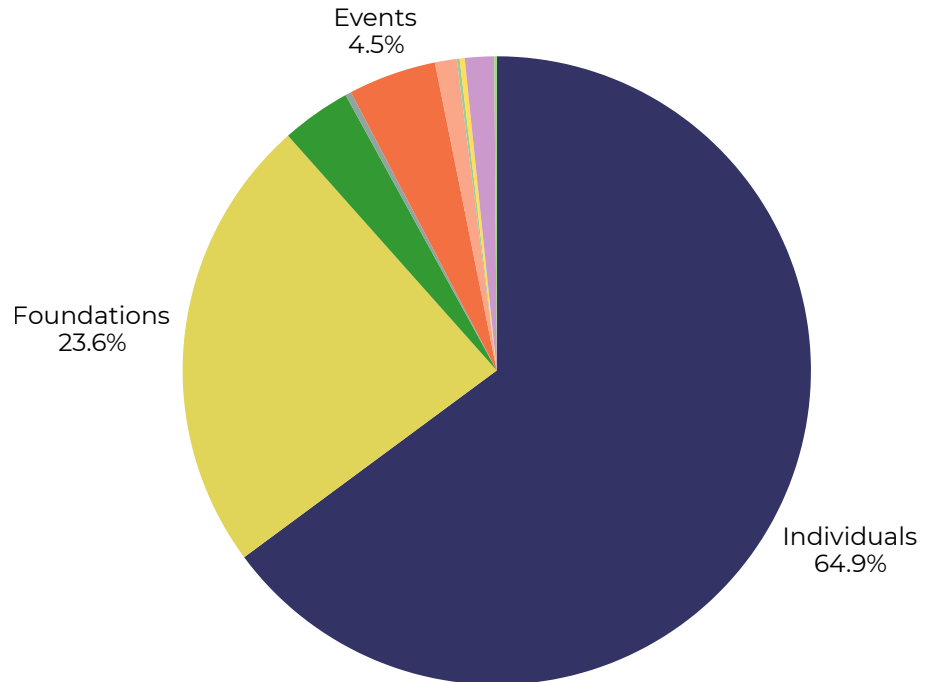

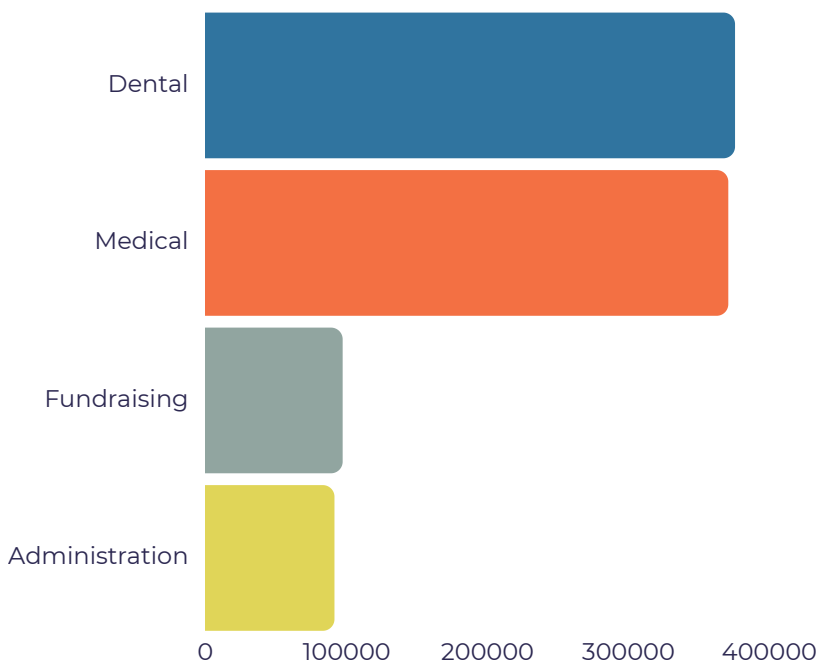


FY 24-25 Revenue*

- Individuals: \$594,300
- Foundations: \$215,918
- Events: \$41,478

FY 24-25 Expenses*



- Dental: \$375,890
- Medical: \$371,105
- Fundraising: \$97,381
- Administration: \$91,570

Revenue totaled \$916,192, and expenses were \$935,948 during FY24-25, creating a deficit of \$19,756. This was largely related to one-time move and facilities expenses.

*We received and spent \$607,533 from the Health Resources and Services Administration for renovations.

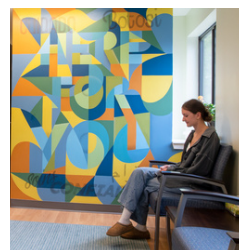
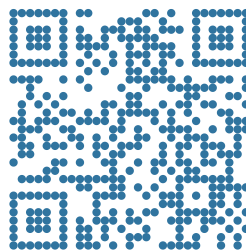
